1. **Implementation of Local Laws** – Following closure of Public Hearings on 12/15/2020, potential adoption:
 - a. **Local Law No. 6 of 2021** – Amending Esopus Town Code § 123-61 “Terms Defined” to Include the Definition of Motor Freight Terminal
 - b. **Local Law No. 7 of 2021** – Amending Esopus Town Code § 123-10 Attachment 1 “Schedule of Permitted Uses” to Add Use Regulations for Motor Freight Terminal

2. **Proposed Local Laws** – review and potential setting of public hearing date(s) for the following proposed laws:
 - a. **Proposed Local Law No. 8 of 2021** – Repealing Chapter 123, “Zoning”, and replacing it with a new Chapter 123, “Zoning”.
 - b. **Proposed Local Law No. 9 of 2021** – Amending Esopus Town Code Chapter 113, “Abandoned Vehicles.”
 - c. **Proposed Local Law No. 10 of 2021** – Repealing Chapter 96, “Lawn Maintenance”, and replacing it with a new Chapter 96, “Property Maintenance.”
 - d. **Proposed Local Law No. 11 of 2021** – Creating a new Chapter 101 of the Esopus Town Code, “Rental Properties Registration.”
 - e. **Proposed Local Law No. 12 of 2021** – Creating a new Chapter 91 of the Esopus Town Code, “Noise Control.”

UPDATES

1. **New Entryway Signage & Pavilions** – the Bruderhof is donating three new 20’ x 30’ park pavilions and a suite of sixteen new ‘Welcome to Town’ entryway signs tailored for each hamlet.
2. **Communicable Disease Operations Plan** – as required by NYS Assembly Bill A10832 and NYS Senate Bill S8617B, public employers are required to develop and adopt a plan for operations in the event of a declared public health emergency involving a communicable disease. Target date for sharing draft with union by Friday, March 5; finalized plan to be ready by Thursday, April 1.
3. **Potential Executive Session** – to discuss the history of an employee in the Highway Department, and to interview an applicant for the Custodian position.
